## FLOWER SHOW SCHOOL I CURRICULUM

### FLOWER SHOW PROCEDURE

Introduction to the *Handbook for Flower Shows*:  
Flower show composition, including hierarchy, including overview of divisions, sections, classes and subclasses.  
Definition and purposes for Standard Flower Shows –Basic requirements, Categories, Types, Standard System of Awarding; Explanation of Non-Top Exhibitor Awards (Best in Show, Sweepstakes, Award of Appreciation) and an overview of the Flower Show Schedule.

### HORTICULTURE

HB, & Horticulture Exhibiting Required Reading for Selected Plant Groups to be studied. General horticulture course curriculum. Introduction and Explanation of Nomenclature and Plant Classification. How to fill out entry cards. Horticulture Exhibiting Procedure; General Requirements for all Horticulture Top Exhibitor Awards (Section awards and Division awards); Judging procedures, etiquette, ethics, and procedure for judging horticulture, horticulture comments, and Practice Point Scoring Exam. Review HB Horticulture Glossary.

**Study selected plants: Pinus and Cucurbits**

### DESIGN

HB, Brief History of Floral Designs including European and American designs including Mid-20<sup>th</sup> Century Traditional Designs; Selecting Containers, mechanics, and plant materials; Conditioning Plant Materials; ELEMENTS and PRINCIPLES of DESIGN in detail; General Requirements for all Top Exhibitor Awards and Design Top Exhibitor Awards; Section awards, Tricolor and Award of Distinction; Division awards: Award of Design Excellence and the Holiday Excellence awards. Judging qualities which appear on all Design Point Scoring forms; Point Scoring Procedure for FSS I Designs; Practice Point Scoring Exam, Design Judging ethics, etiquette, and procedure. Discuss Design commenting vocabulary. Review HB Design Glossary.
